



## Rosoboronexport at MCIS-2017

Rosoboronexport, Rostec's member, is taking part at the 6th Moscow International Security Conference MCIS-2017 held under auspices of the Russian Ministry of Defense at the Redisson Royal Hotel, Moscow, on April 26-27, where it set up a booth.

The event has brought together heads of defense and law enforcement agencies of numerous states and international organizations.
